

Milwaukee City Hall Environmental Remediation

Phases:

Phase I involved the fourth floor of City Hall. Contaminated materials were removed from the floor, including the restrooms. This phase began July 7, 2003, and was completed in two days. Phase II was a similar abatement of the men's and women's basement-level restrooms in City Hall. This phase began Sept.. 24, 2003, and was completed that same week on Sept.. 26, 2003. Phase III involved abating basement pipes on Sept.. 26, 2003.

Overview:

During a general remodeling of Milwaukee's City Hall, KPH is involved in several specific jobs that require expertise in environmental remediation.

Duration:

Although three phases have been completed, the project is ongoing. KPH is responding to the general contractor's remodeling schedule, and completing the work as quickly as possible to allow the remodeling to continue.

Scope of Project:

KPH is responding as needed during the remodeling. Work to date has included complete abatement of contaminated materials from the fourth floor and the removal of fittings and pipe insulation from several areas in the building.
